**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
BETWEEN**

and

GOVT. GIRLS GENERAL DEGREE COLLEGE, EKBALPURA

This Memorandum of Understanding is made on Monday, 16th of September, 2019

BETWEEN St. Xavier's College (Autonomous), having an address at 30, Mother Teresa, Sarani (Park Street), Kolkata - 700016 AND GOVT. GIRLS GENERAL DEGREE COLLEGE, having an address at 7, MAYURBHANJ ROAD, KOLKATA-700023.

WHEREAS:

St. Xavier's College (Autonomous), Kolkata and GOVT. GIRLS GENERAL DEGREE COLLEGE, EKBALPURA recognizing the importance of the UGC Quality Mandate, have agreed to enter into this Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) regarding enhancement of the overall quality of the latter Higher Education Institute.

Both Parties HEREBY AGREE:

A. MENTORING PROGRAMME

St. Xavier's College (Autonomous), Kolkata will be the Mentor institution and GOVT GIRLS GEN. DEGREE COLLEGE, EKBALPURA will be a Mentee institution to be mentored by the former under the scheme "PARAMARSH" sanctioned by UGC. The main activity of the Mentor institution will be to prepare the Mentee institution to get accredited by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council. The activities under this scheme will be carried out at both Mentor and Mentee institutions. The mentor will identify the potential areas of improvement in assessment criteria for accreditation in the mentee institution such as Curricular Aspects, Teaching-Learning and Evaluation, Research, Innovation & Extension, Institutional Values and Best Practices. The mentoring activities will comprise of Lectures, Training a Core Group, Question Answer Sessions, Organizing Workshops, Assessment of Mentee institution, Conducting Mock Accreditation process and other similar exercises.

B. COMPLIANCE WITH LAWS

Both Parties will comply with all relevant laws in the jurisdiction in which it is in situ and all visiting scholars shall comply with all relevant laws in the jurisdiction of the host Party.

C. NO AGENCY

Nothing in this MOU gives rise to a relationship of agency between the Parties.

D. NO JOINT VENTURE, PARTNERSHIP OR EMPLOYMENT RELATIONSHIP

Nothing in this MOU shall be relied upon to construe a joint venture, partnership or employment relationship between the Parties.

E. NO TENANCY OR INTEREST IN PROPERTY

Nothing in this MOU shall create or shall be construed to create any tenancy or to confer or be construed to confer upon on Party any interest in any, all or part of the grounds, building or premises of the other Party.

F. TERMS OF RENEWAL AND AMENDMENT

This MOU shall remain in force for a period of *one (01)* year from the execution date at the beginning of this MOU. This MOU may only be renewed if, after a review process between the Parties, the Parties agree in writing to renew it and the UGC approves of such extension, by a maximum period of six months. This MOU may be amended by the exchange of letters between the two Parties. Such amendments, once approved by both Parties, will become part of this MOU. Neither Party may assign this MOU or any right under this MOU without the prior written consent of the other Party.

G. NOTICES

Any notice or other communication to any party hereto (whether required or permitted to be given under or in connection with this MOU) shall be in writing and shall (at the option of the Party giving the notice) be sent by registered post to the address set out under its name below, or to such other address as is from time to time notified to the Party giving the notice in compliance with the provisions of this clause G:



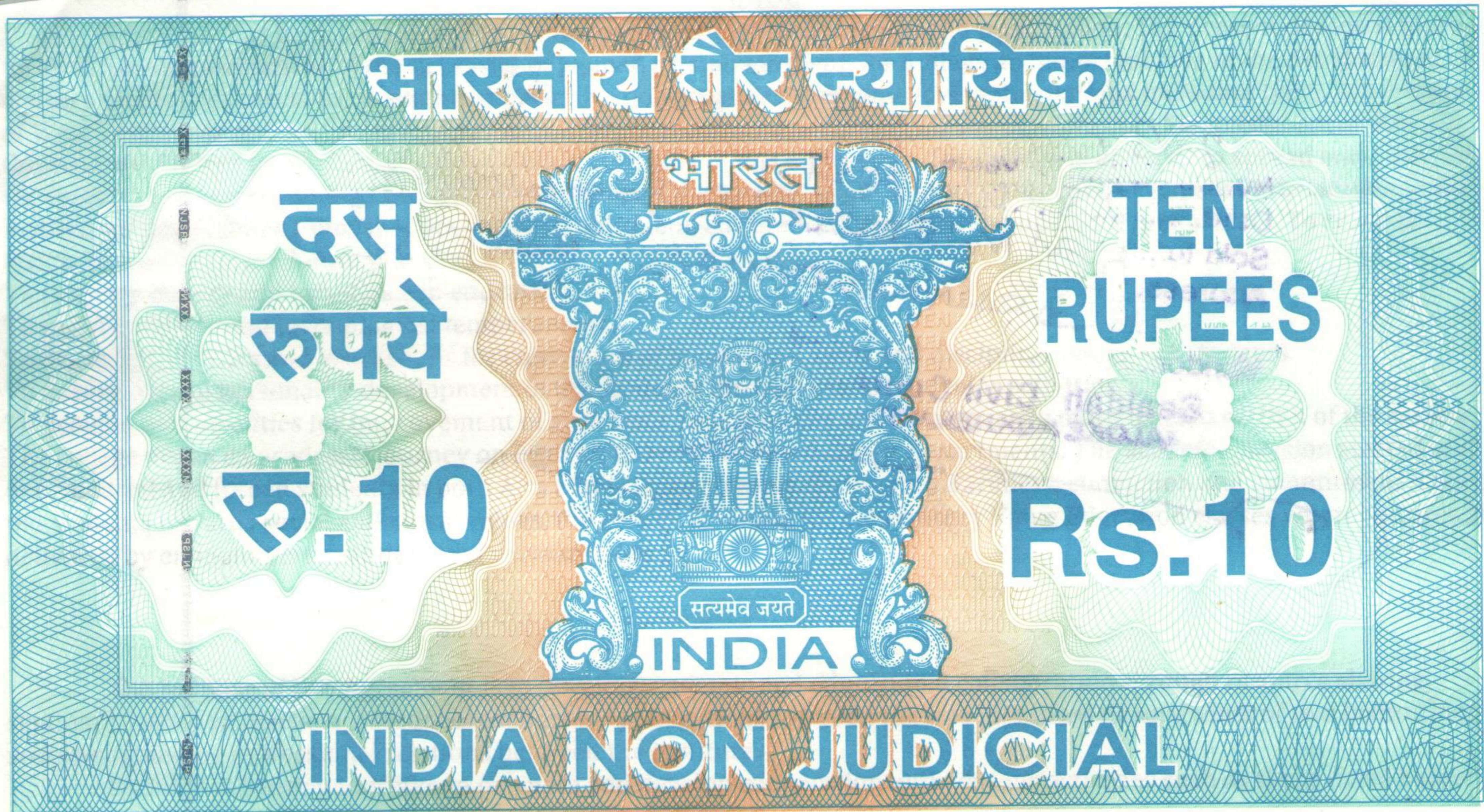

This agreement is entered into by Hiralal Mazumdar Memorial College for Women (HMMCW), Dakshineswar, Kolkata - 700035, West Bengal affiliated under West Bengal State University and Government Girls' General Degree College (GGDC), 7, Mayurbhanj Road, Ekbalpur, Kolkata - 700023, West Bengal affiliated under University of Calcutta and effective as of 18th November of 2021.

HMMCW

Hiralal Mazumdar Memorial College For Women (HMMCW) was established on 10.08.1959 following the idea of imparting education to the women folk of the area. The campus of the college is one aspect that sets it apart from other colleges in the region. The green open space in the college and adjacent pond act like an oasis of the college. The staff and the students of the college make it vibrant and retain a strong sense of community and openness of the campus creates a relaxed ambience. The college embraces the ideals of discipline, determination and dedication as basic principles that would not only help students to spread the wings but also gradually guide us to the path of perfection with honesty, integrity and humility. The mission of the college is to educate, empower and emancipate in compliance with the needs of the society. Re-Accredited as a B++ graded college in 2016 by NAAC, we are now striving through the path of excellence and to elevate ourselves further in the path of prosperity.

At present, the college is offering 18 (eighteen) Honours courses and 27 (twenty seven) General courses under the UG Course Curriculum of West Bengal State University to cater to the needs of approximately 1300 (One thousand three Hundred) strong student community.

Education has been considered as a key instrument for social change and progression. The present decade is marked by an increasing awareness of the necessity of women's empowerment, for it plays an important role in the development of a country. Higher education for women has become a policy agenda for many developing nations including India. Government of West Bengal has also taken various steps to enhance women's position by means of education. Establishment of this Government College for Girls at Ekbalpur, Kolkata is a part of this endeavour. The college is directed to spread and improve the quality of education among all sections of women in the society. In other words, this college visualizes the academic and intellectual development, moral uplift, social commitment, cultural refinement of the upcoming generation. To reach the vision following are the future plans:

To cultivate quality and excellence in education.

To boost scientific and technological temperament.

To organize Seminars and Workshops for cultivation of knowledge, skills and discipline among the students.

To ensure overall personality development of the students through extra-curricular activities.

To provide opportunities for improvement of girls from educationally and economically marginalized section of the society.

The college began its academic journey on 28th January 2016 with thirteen departments. The academic session started with one hundred and fifteen students in both Arts and Science streams. To create awareness, conviction and commitment among the students towards social and moral values, the college arranges for compulsory Value Education classes where lectures are delivered by eminent personalities from various fields.

The purpose of this Agreement is to develop academic and educational collaboration through resource sharing, seminars, talks and teachers / students exchange / publications between the two identified departments of two institutions and strengthening professional relations between the institutes.

Both the colleges undertake to promote and develop cooperation with various activities such as those listed below on the basis of equality and reciprocity:

1. Students of the both institutions will have equal access to quality enhancement programmes organised by both the institutions.
2. It is understood that implementation of any of the type of cooperation stated in clause 1 and mentioned above shall depend upon the availability of resources and financial support at the institutions concerned.
3. This agreement shall remain in force for three years if either institution does not terminate it by a minimum of a six month's written notification to the other institution.
4. This agreement may at any time be revised or modified, by mutual consent, within the period agreed upon by way of clause 3 mentioned above.

Scope:

This Memorandum of Understanding witnesses that the institutions wish to explore the possibility of collaborating together in various ways including:

- a) Exchange of knowledge;
 - b) Taking Online / Offline classes by faculty members of the Departments of Chemistry, Commerce, Geography, History, Sociology, Urdu, English, etc. after mutual decision by both the colleges;
 - c) Development of joint research activities; while implementing the matters related to research, Research Scholars and Research Guides of both institutions will follow the rules and regulations of Government and the affiliating University as and where applicable;
 - d) To organise joint seminars and symposia in India. HMMCW & GGGDC will collaborate in designing and organising seminars, training program, symposia for the participants of both the colleges and also neighbouring colleges including those belonging to other universities;
 - e) To collaborate in Library Arrangement Programme
- The above collaboration will include all the Departments, Faculties of both HMMCW and GGGDC.


Terms of MOU:

Kolkata – 700023 hereinafter referred to as GGGD COLLEGE, (which expression where the context so admits include its successors and permitted assignees) of the other part has to state that whereas GGGD COLLEGE is desirous to continue the existing Computer Courses at its premises.

and whereas **Company** offered to continue the aforesaid Computer Course assistance by way of providing necessary support for the said course as mutually agreed in the meeting between the **Company** & GGGD College followed by the letter no. 2020/A/GGGDC dated 22.02.2022 from the College.

The immediate goal of this collaboration is to develop and run a self-financing course in Computer Course of not more than two years durations at GGGD COLLEGE, at the conclusion of which each successful student will be issued a **Diploma in Computer Application** by the Company.

To fulfill this objective

The Company shall

Frame a course keeping in mind the basic demand in the market as mentioned above. Advanced level modules may be introduced in the third year depending on students demand.

- Teach each level for a duration of One Hundred & twenty (120) hours of teaching time at the rate of two (2) classes per week under normal circumstances.
- Arrange & conduct class tests and qualifying examination according a schedule in keeping with the academic calendar of the College.

GGGD College shall

- Appoint a coordinator from among the members of the Teaching Faculty of the college to liaise with the designated faculty / representatives of WIL regarding matters relating to the smooth running of the said course.
- Motivate all Students to take up the Course irrespective of any stream.
Provide classrooms and audio- visual aids as may be required from time to time.
- Facilitate the holding of Examination.

Both COMPANY and GGGD COLLEGE are in agreement that

- This MOA is renewed for a term of Three (3) years w.e.f the date of execution of this agreement. On completion of the agreement, i.e., 3 years, Company shall have the option to renew the agreement on mutually agreed terms and conditions. However, in the event of renewal, Company shall put its option by a 3 months prior notice to GGGD COLLEGE before the expiry of the initial term.
- Fees for entire course (120 hours) shall be ₹2,400.00 for each students at present payable at the time of admission for the period between 2022-2025.

- GGGD COLLEGE will get @10% of the total course fees on account of its share, which the Company/Training Provider will pay to GGGD COLLEGE at the end of each admission procedure in each session.
- The classes will be set between 9.15 am and 5.30 pm on each working day accommodating them within normal class hours as far as is permitted by the general routine of the College. If necessary classes may be held on Saturdays & Sundays or on holidays depending on the requirement of the course. Computer Practice sessions for students may be arranged during the College hours according to student/s availability.
- Both the COMPANY & GGGD COLLEGE shall not be liable for any obligation hereunder to the extent that the Performance of the relative obligation is prevented by the existence of a Force Majeure of any Nature and shall be suspended from the obligation owing to the duration of Force Majeure.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF IUCAA's ASSOCIATESHIP PROGRAMME

- Visiting Associateship is awarded to a faculty member of a college, university department or institution, which has the status of a university recognized by the UGC.
- Visiting Associateship is awarded for a period of three years at a time. If a Visiting Associate ceases to have a formal link with a college or university during the period of an Associateship, then the Associateship stands terminated. Information regarding such a change should be conveyed to the Dean, Visitor Academic Programmes.
- A Visiting Associate can visit IUCAA a maximum of three times as an Associate during each academic year, which extends from August 1 to July 31. There has to be at least one visit during each academic year.
- A visit under the Visiting Associateship programme has to be preferably at least of 15 days duration. A maximum of 150 days can be spent at IUCAA during any one academic year.
- During the three year period of a Visiting Associateship, there can be a maximum of six visits, totally to a maximum of 365 days.
- **Travel:** It is expected that journeys will generally be by air or rail or road by the direct shortest route. All Visiting Associates are entitled to travel by train AC-II tier. Travel reimbursement will only be to the extent of the actual class of travel upto AC-II tier. The claimant will have to produce to and fro tickets/copies of tickets.

Limited funds are available for air travel of Visiting Associates. Air travel may be permitted subject to the following conditions:

- (a) Grade Pay of the claimant is at least Rs. 5400/- or equivalent per month.
- (b) The claimant stays at IUCAA for a minimum of 15 days.
- (c) Air travel should be by Air India flights only as per GOI rules.

Even when these conditions are satisfied, **prior approval from the Dean, Visitor Academic Programmes** will have to be obtained. Air travel over special sectors, especially in the North-Eastern parts of the country, may be permitted even when the conditions (a) and (b) are not met. Details about this may be had from the Administrative Officer (Visitor Services). The air travel will have to be by the shortest direct route. Those who are not eligible for air travel can choose to travel by air with the understanding that they will be reimbursed only to the extent of eligible train fare or actual air fare, whichever is lower.

- **Daily Allowance (DA):** Visiting Associates are paid DA @ Rs. 600/- per day with free lodging. Charges for Canteen, Cable TV and cooking gas, wherever applicable, will be recovered.
- **Acknowledgement :** Visiting Associates should not give IUCAA as their affiliation. But those who use the IUCAA facilities for research work leading to publications should acknowledge IUCAA in their publication.
- **Accommodation :** We try to ensure that Visiting Associates are accommodated whenever they wish to visit IUCAA. However, there is very high demand during vacations, when most visitors like to come to IUCAA. All intending visitors are, therefore, urged to write to us about their plans for a stay at IUCAA at least two months in advance. This is particularly necessary for family accommodation, since the number of units, which can accommodate families is very limited. Please write to us well in advance with alternative dates and await confirmation from us. You will be guaranteed accommodation on arrival at IUCAA only if you have a word of confirmation sent by us.
- **Visit by research students of Visiting Associates:** The students should write to the Dean, Visitor Academic Programmes, along with a copy of their bio-data, proposed plan of work at IUCAA, and a recommendation by the concerned Visiting Associate.

At a given time, only one student of a Visiting Associate can visit IUCAA. It is not essential for the guide/the concerned Visiting Associate to be present at the time of a student's visit, except for students who are visiting for the first time.

The DA entitlement for research students (registered for M. Phil/Ph.D.) is Rs. 300/- per day with free lodging, and canteen will be charged. They are entitled to travel by train by AC Chair Car or AC –III tier by the direct shortest route. Travel by AC-II tier will be permitted only if the trains on the shortest route do not have any of the above classes. The tickets/copies of the tickets will have to be submitted with the claim. However, the following provisions apply:

Research Students with fellowship: Students with fellowship will have to pay for travel from their contingency grant. When such a grant is not available, they should write in advance to the Dean, Visitor Academic Programmes for travel reimbursement.

Research Students without fellowship: They will be paid for their travel and DA (with free lodging; canteen will be charged), for the full period of their stay. The guide of such students will have to submit a letter to the effect that the students do not have fellowship.

At the end of the visit, all students are required to submit a report to the Dean, Visitor Academic Programmes about the work done at IUCAA.
