

5. About Energy Audit

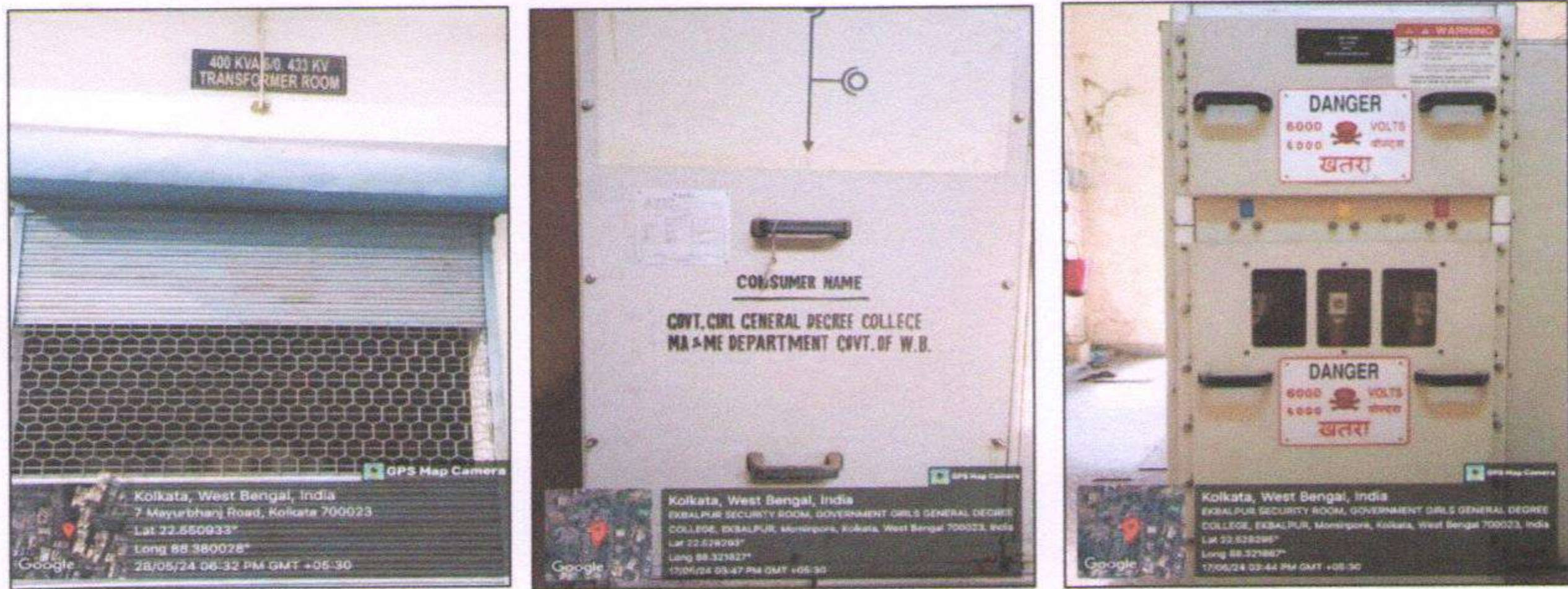


Figure 1. Power Management System of this Institution

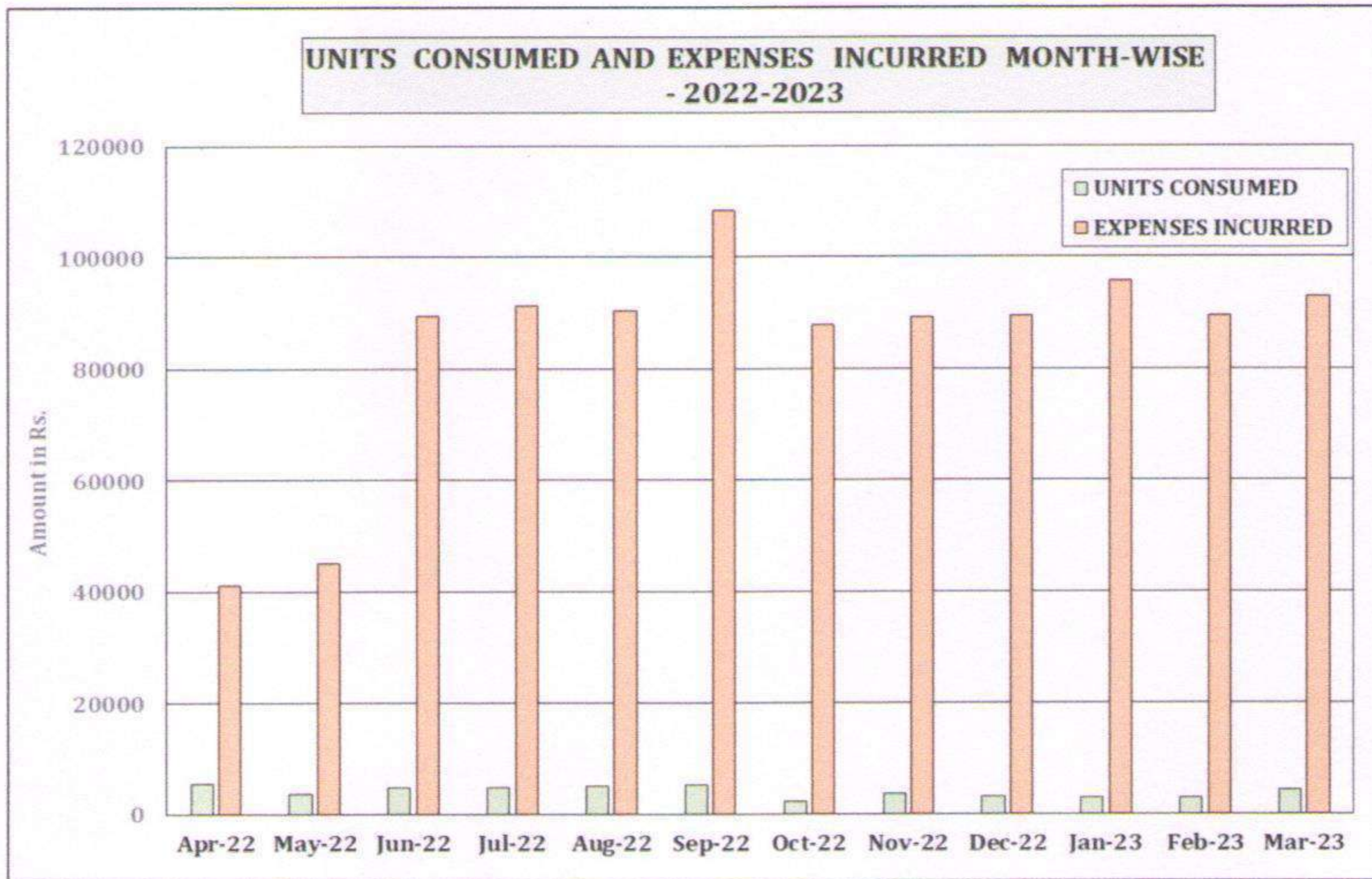


Figure 2. Graphical presentation of units consumed with expenses incurred monthwise for the F.Y. Year of 2022-23

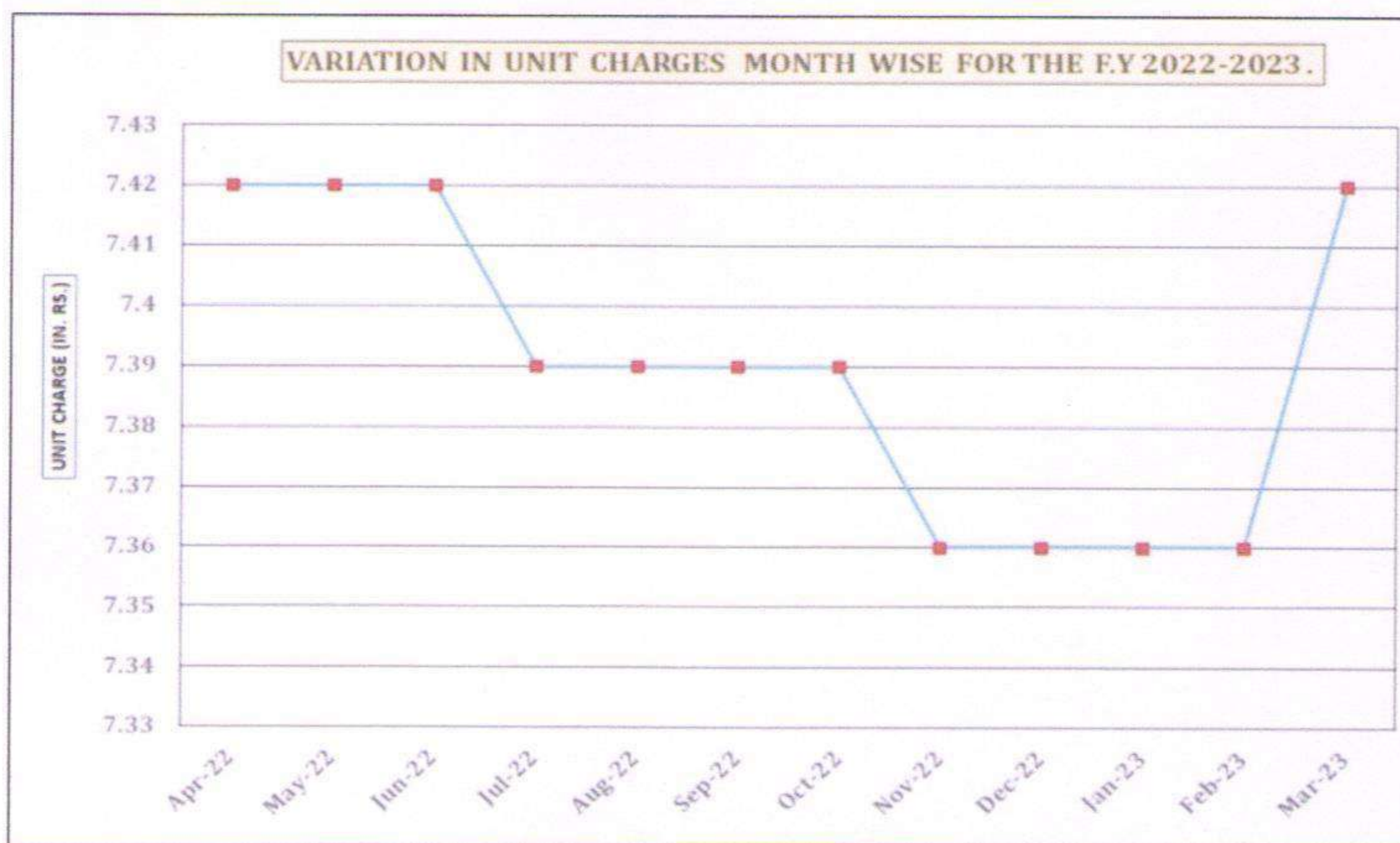


Figure 3. Graphical presentation of variation of per unit charges monhwise for the F. Y. Year of 2022-23

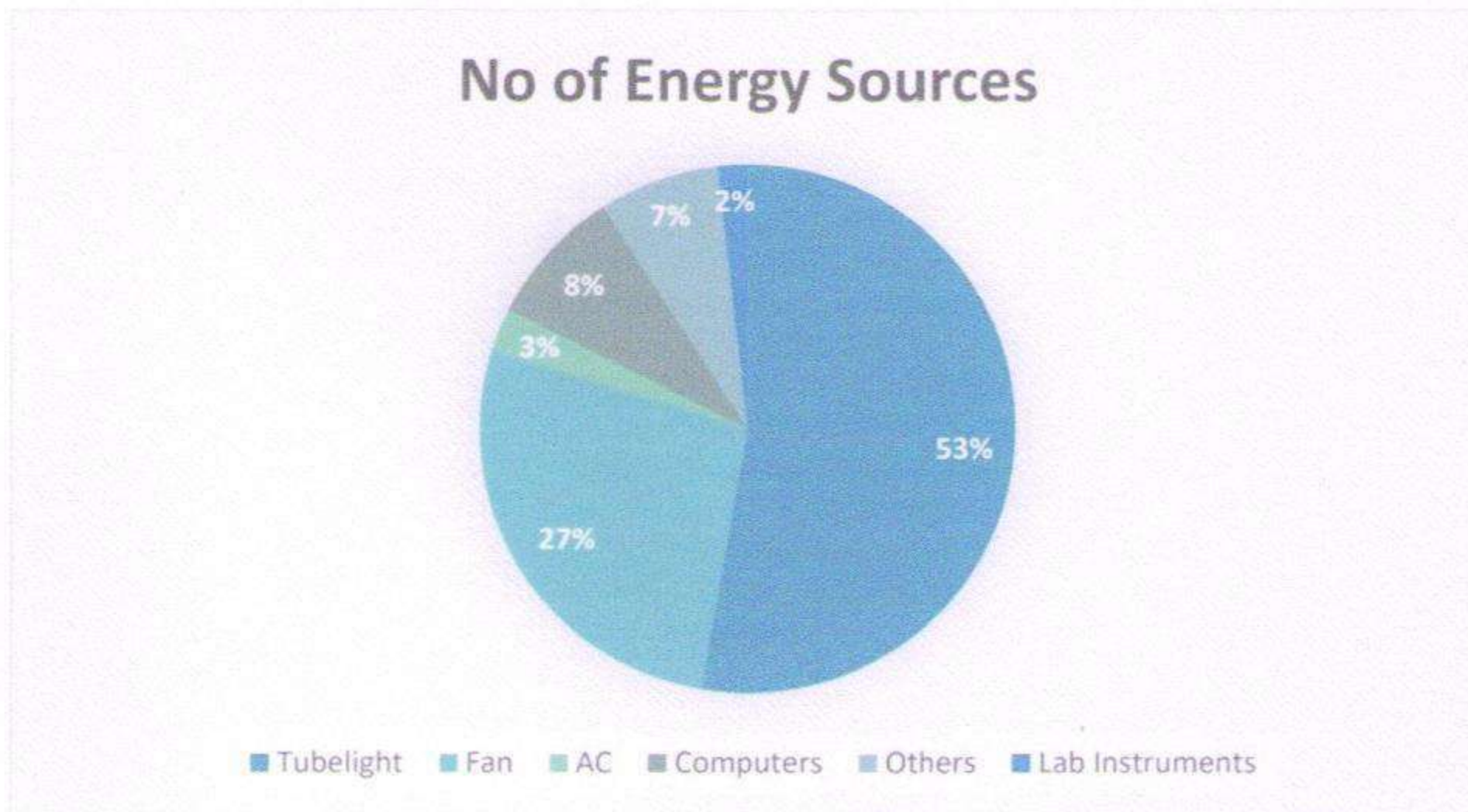


Figure 4: Pi Chart of load distribution across different fixture

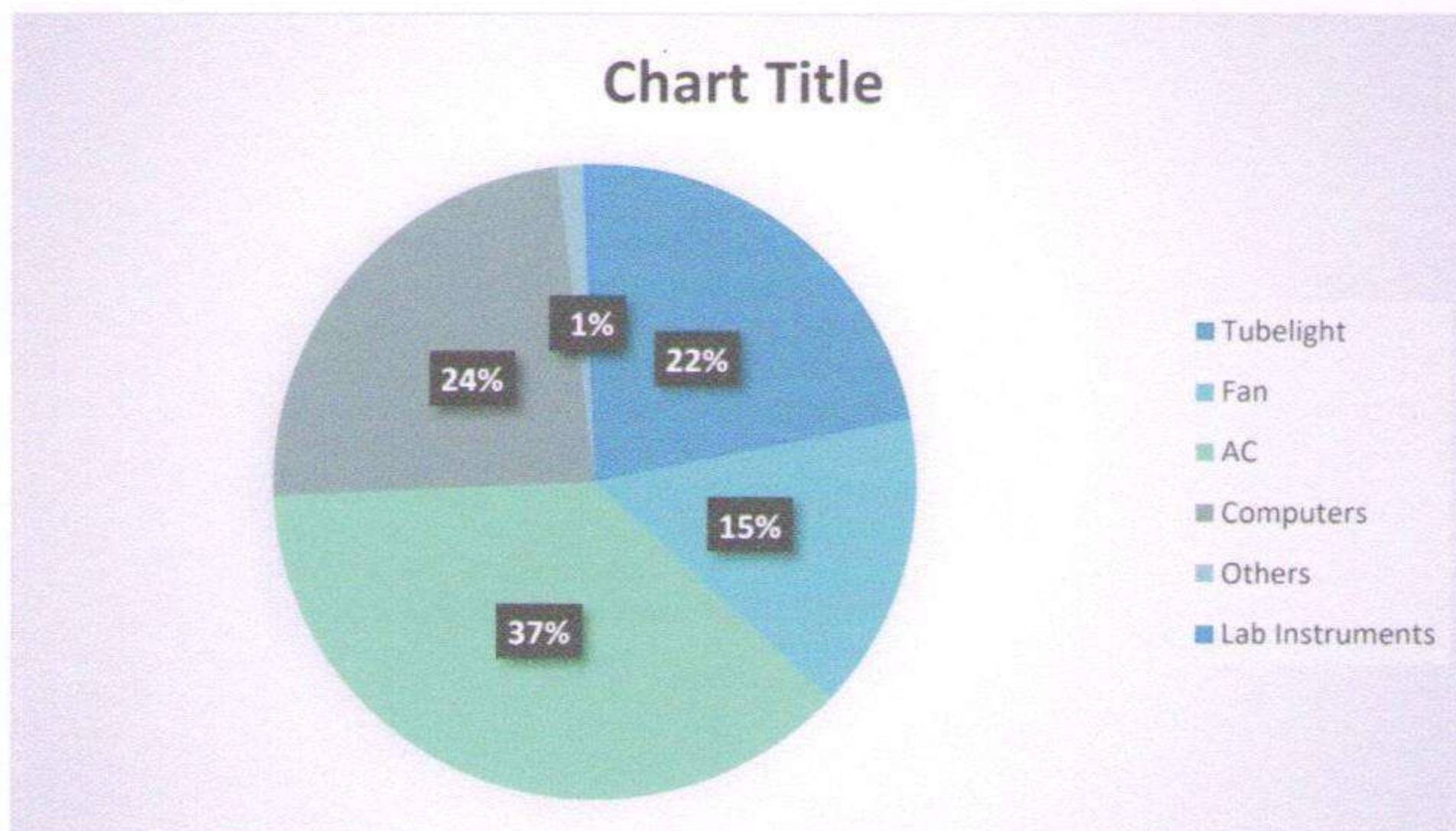


Figure 5: Pi Chart for % of energy consumption of each type of energy sources

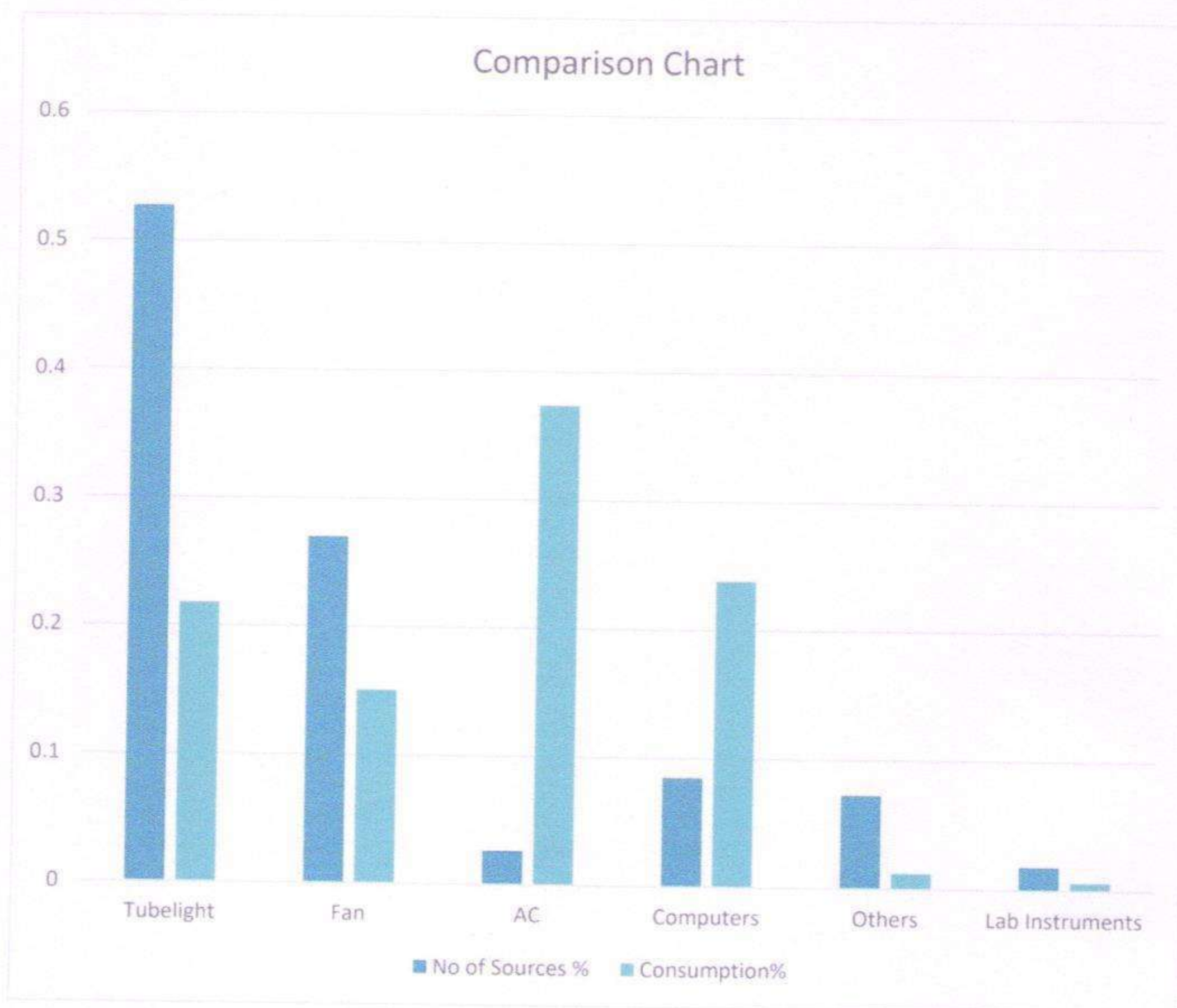

Total number of major energy consuming sources found in the college premises are 988. Majority of sources used are tube lights (521) and different types of fans (267). The other notable categories of sources are Air conditioners (26), Computers (84), Laboratory instruments (18) and Others (72).

The annual energy consumption of each type of energy sources have been estimated by multiplying corresponding wattage with daily active hours and number of active days in a year. The result shows that highest amount of energy is consumed by A.C.s(37%) followed by computers (24%), tube lights (22%) and fans (15%). Laboratory instruments and other devices contributes insignificantly in the total annual consumption. It can be seen from the comparison chart that A.C.s and Computers have higher consumption compared to their counts. On the other hand, tube lights, fans and other devices turns out to be more energy efficient.

In the end, this audit compares the estimated annual energy consumption from gathered data with the actual energy consumption of last year as reflected from the electricity bill. **It is evident from the comparison that the actual energy consumption is 59.5% less than the estimated value which is very much appreciable.** There are two major reasons that have contributed to this difference between estimated and actual value.


1. It clearly indicates the actual duration of active hours are less than given estimated values, which may be interpreted as the users of the energy sources i.e. the students, teachers, and office stuffs have adapted good practices like 'switch off drill' to minimize the energy consumption.
2. The 10KW on-grid solar panel on the roof of the institution produces a significant amount of energy and reduces the net consumption from the grid which is reflected in the electricity bill. From the previous data, the estimated annual production by the solar panel should be around 1500 units.

5.3. Recommendation by the audit team

5.3.1. Lighting: The audit showed that many of the College's lighting fixtures were ineffective and outdated. It is advised to use natural light whenever possible, add occupancy sensors, and swap out conventional light bulbs for energy-efficient LED ones.

5.3.2. Heating, Ventilation, and Air Conditioning (HVAC): The HVAC systems were discovered to be working less efficiently than necessary. Energy usage can be considerably decreased by switching to energy-efficient HVAC equipment, using programmable thermostats, and performing routine maintenance.

5.3.3. Energy Awareness: The College should promote energy conservation practices among employees and students. Campaigns, educational activities, and financial incentives for energy-saving projects can all help achieve this.

6. Action taken report

- Energy efficiency utilization project taken by installing solar photo voltaic cells at the rooftop.
- Conventional light bulbs will be replaced time to time with energy-efficient LED ones. Thirty-nine (39) LED lights of 22 Watt already installed in the campus for energy sustainability.
- Campaign/display project taken to aware other stakeholders thorough postering of slogans in the campus by NSS Unit I volunteers.

6.1. Solar panel of this Institution

Use of Renewable Energy:

keeping in mind the benefits of solar energy to minimize the consumption of electricity which is produced by converting the Sun's radiation – Government Girls' General Degree College authority has initiated to implement it by writing a letter to the Chairman, West Bengal Pollution Control Board. After Material Inspection for design and engineering on 18.02.2021 for the work order given (Work order no. 2821-6K/WPB/274/2018 dated 16.12.2019) a solar panel project was installed (Project Name:50 nos. 10kWp Roof Top Grid Connected SPV Power Plant). The project was completed and is operating successfully on and from 25.02.2021. The above mentioned work was implemented by West Bengal Pollution Control Board, Department of Environment, Govt. of West Bengal and executed by M/s Sunshine Power Products Pvt. Ltd. Project executor, M/s Sunshine Power Products Pvt. Ltd. (Address 130/9, Bakrahat Road, Hanspukur Green Park, Joka, Kolkata-700104) has supplied and installed the above said power plant successfully and will carry out the preventive and routine maintenance support of the system for 5 years as per the ender agreement No. M/WBPB/24/2019-2020 dated 31.12.2019 and LoA vide memo No. 2821/6k/WBPCB/274/2018 dated 16.12.2019.

An agreement was signed on 08.12.2023 between CESC Limited with Government Girls' General Degree College (As "Eligible Consumer") for the Connection of Net Billing. Now the above Solar Plant of the College is interconnected with the electrical installation/network of CESC and will run in parallel with CESC's Distribution System so that the College is benefitted for the entire electrical energy generated from the above solar Plant into CESC's network at approved generic tariff of Rs. 3.17 /kWh, determined by the West Bengal Electricity Regulatory Commission as per the Order I Case No. SM-28/21-22 dated 25 October 2021. The College has paid the Service Charge Bill (Rs. 37760.00, Transaction Date 30.11.2023) for Net Metering through Net banking to CESC.

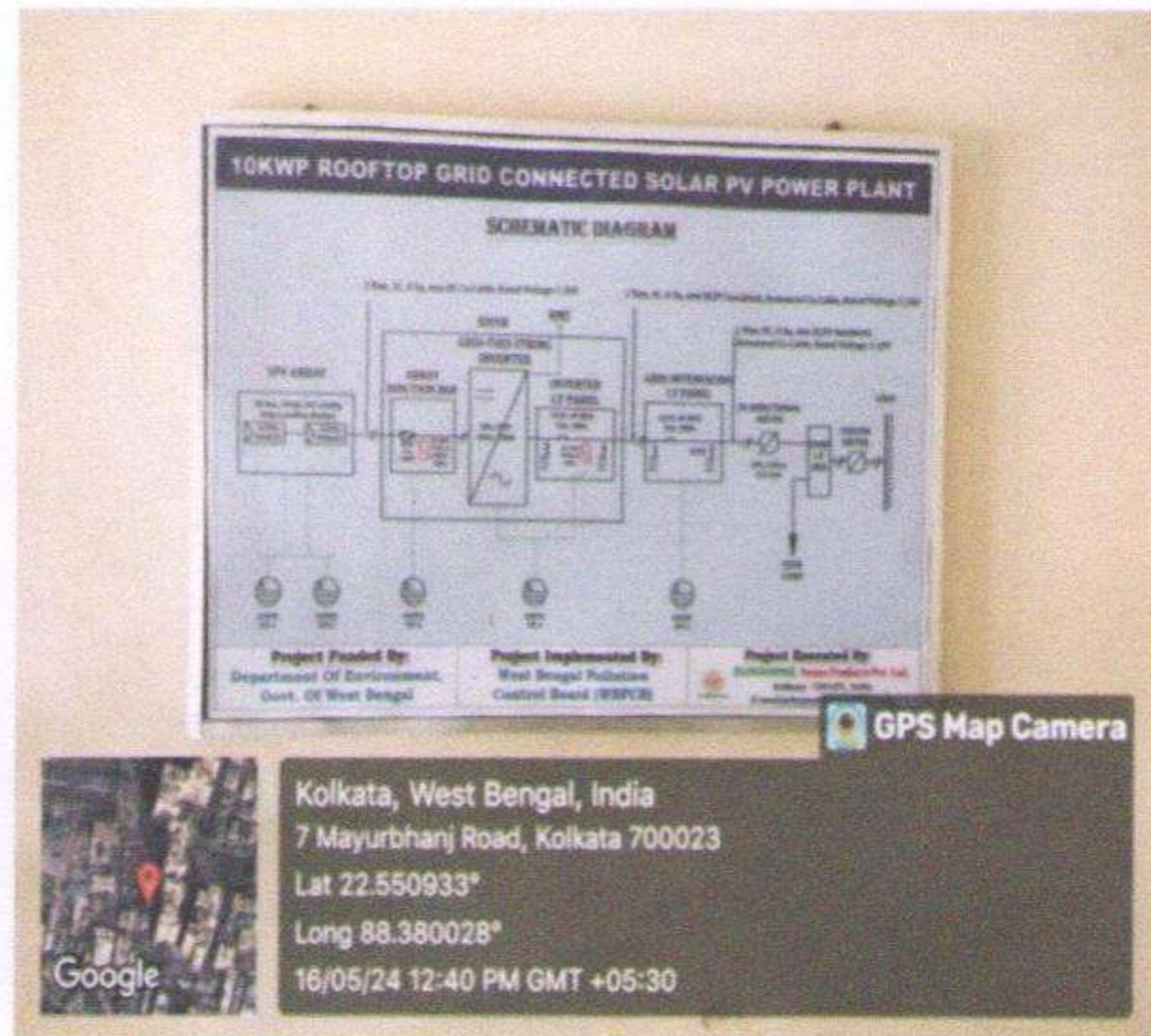
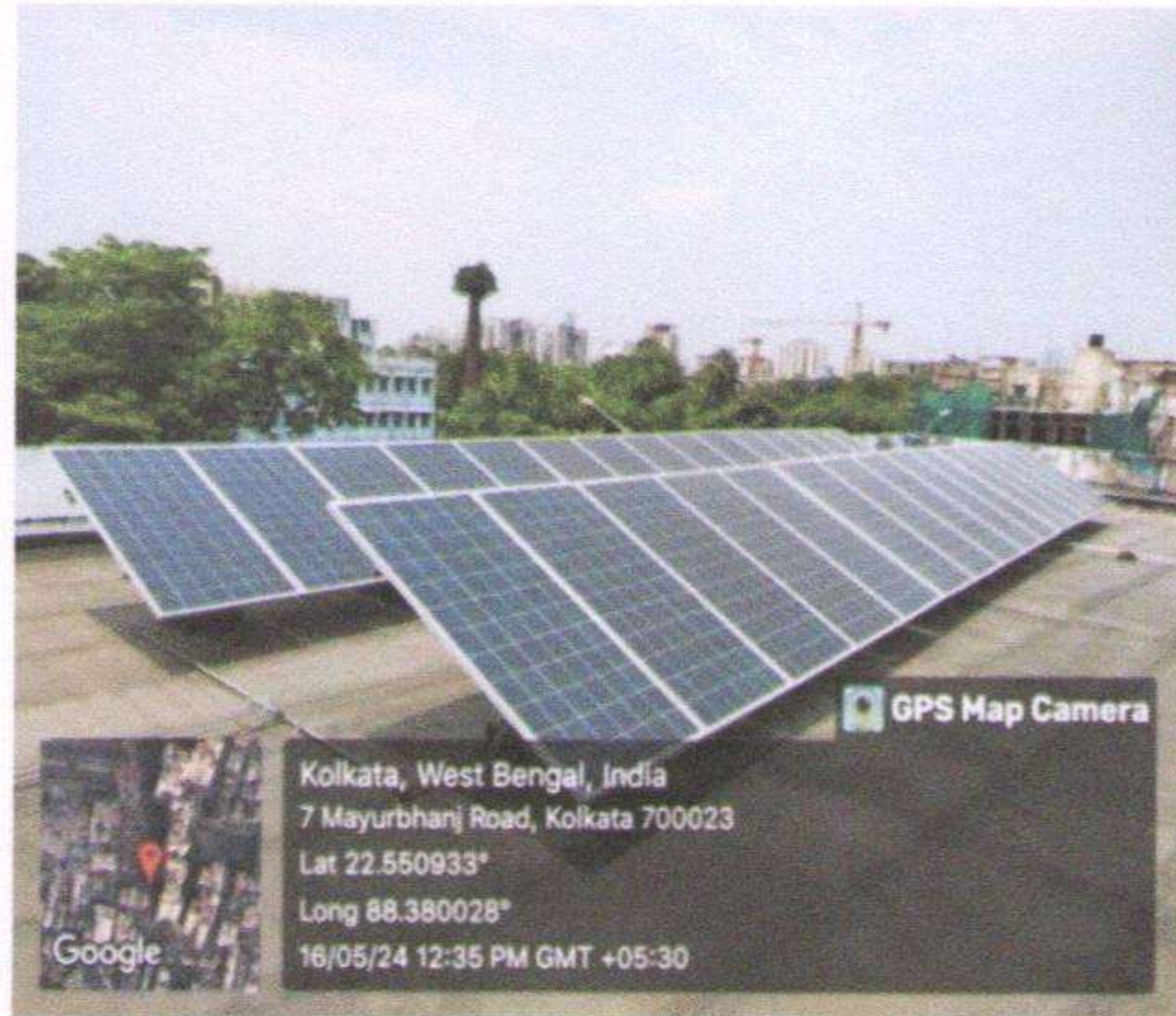


Figure 6: Photograph of Rooftop Solar Panel

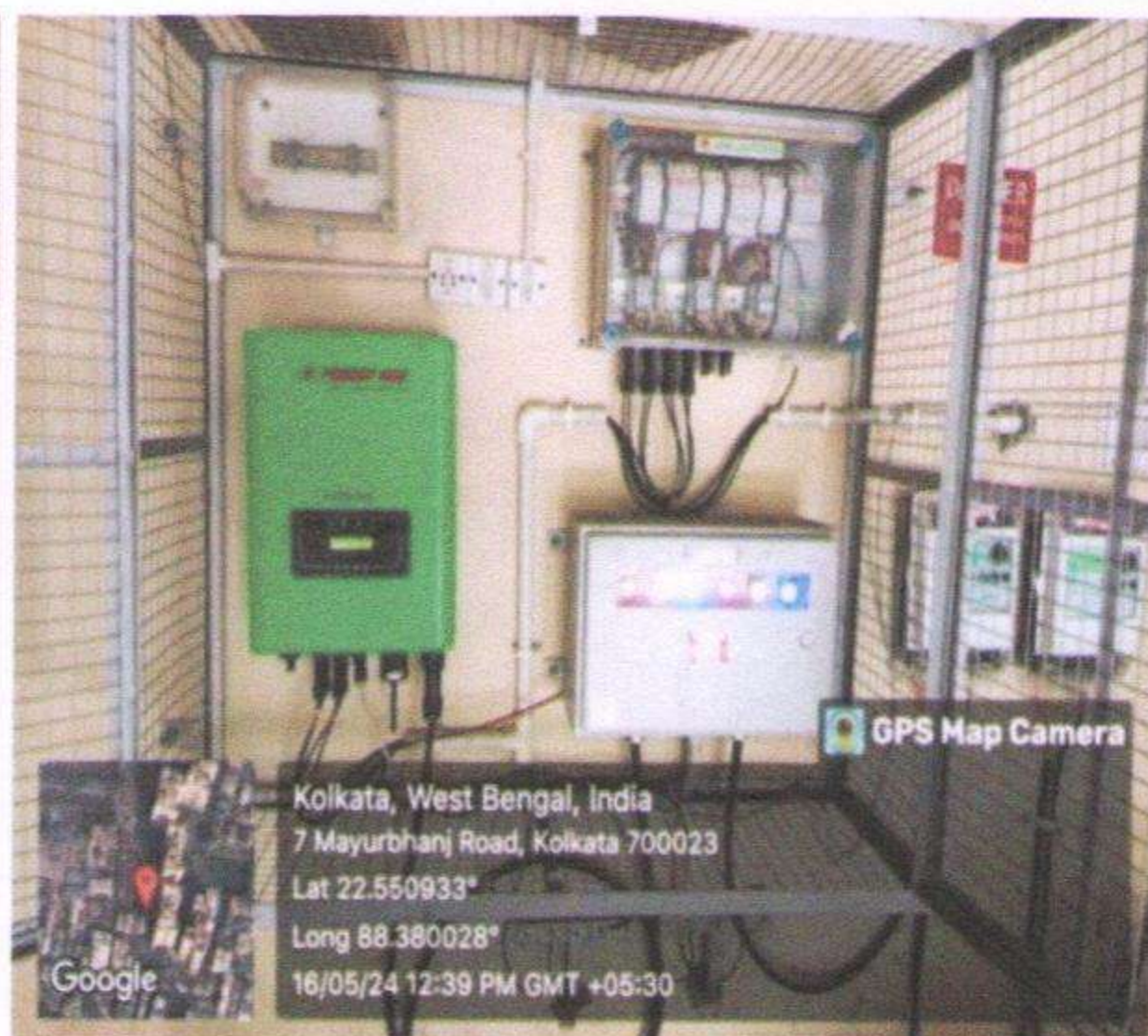


Figure 7: Photographs of Solar meter

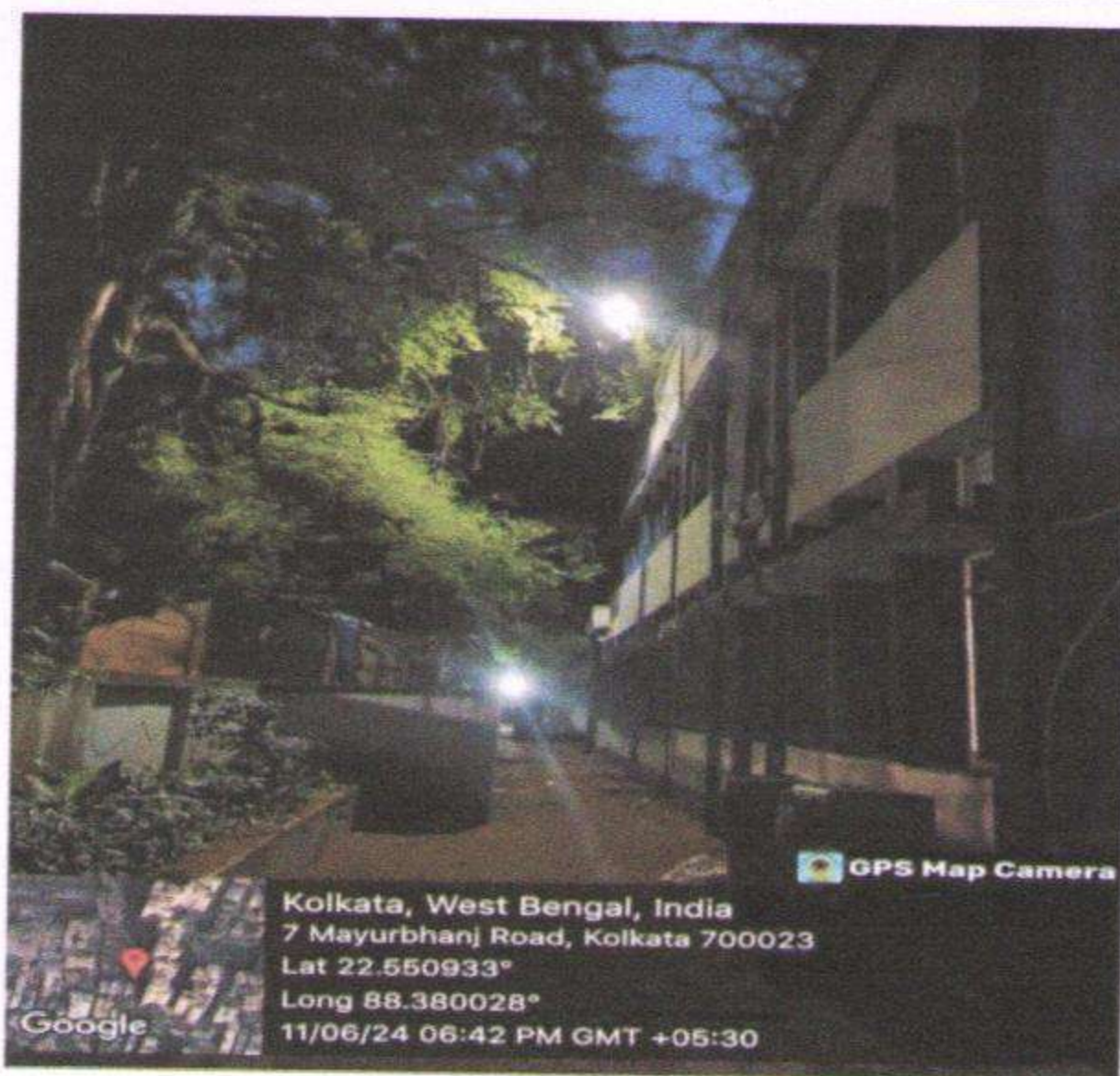


Figure 8: Photographs of LED lighting across the campus

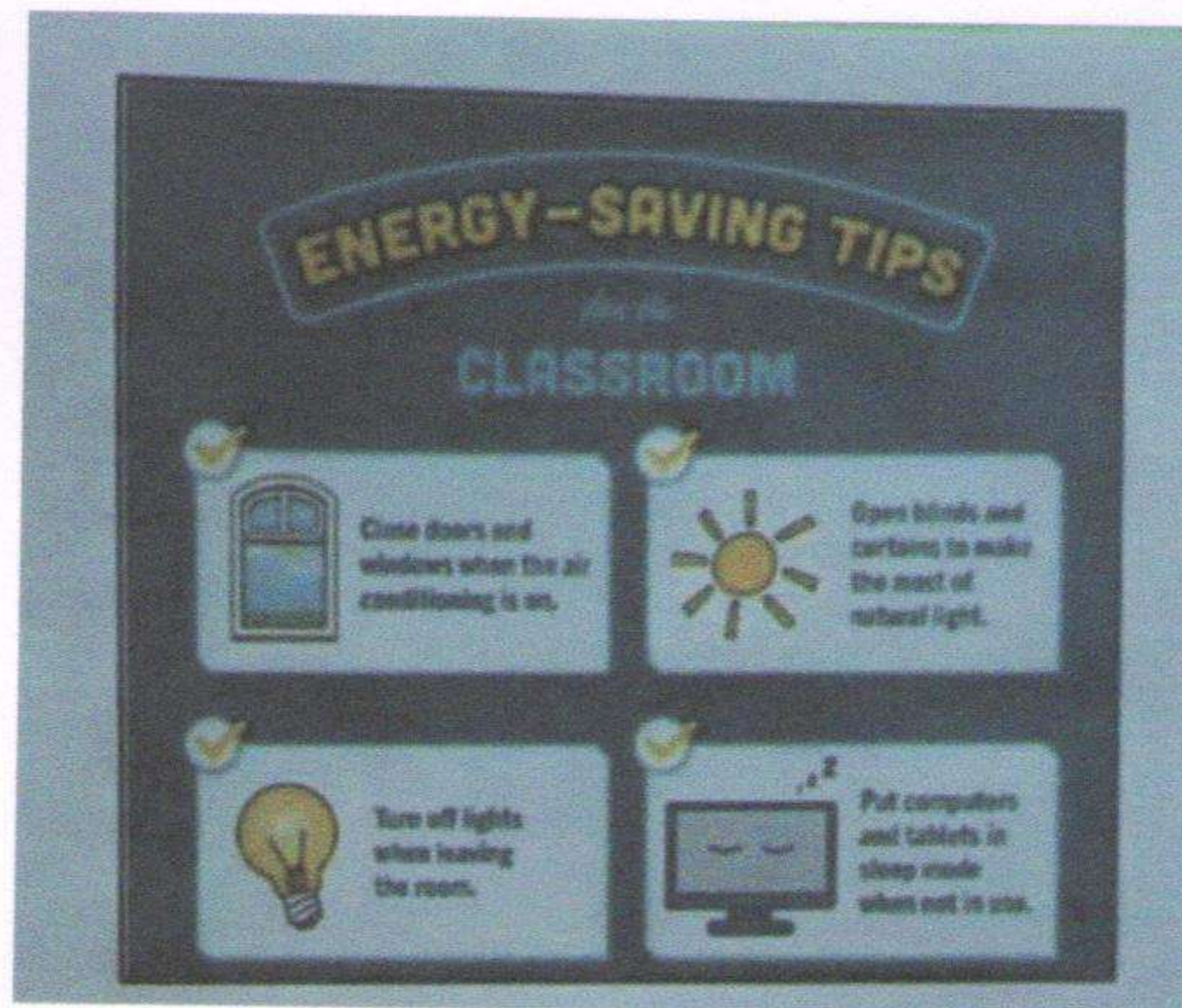


Figure 9: Instructions for energy-saving rules

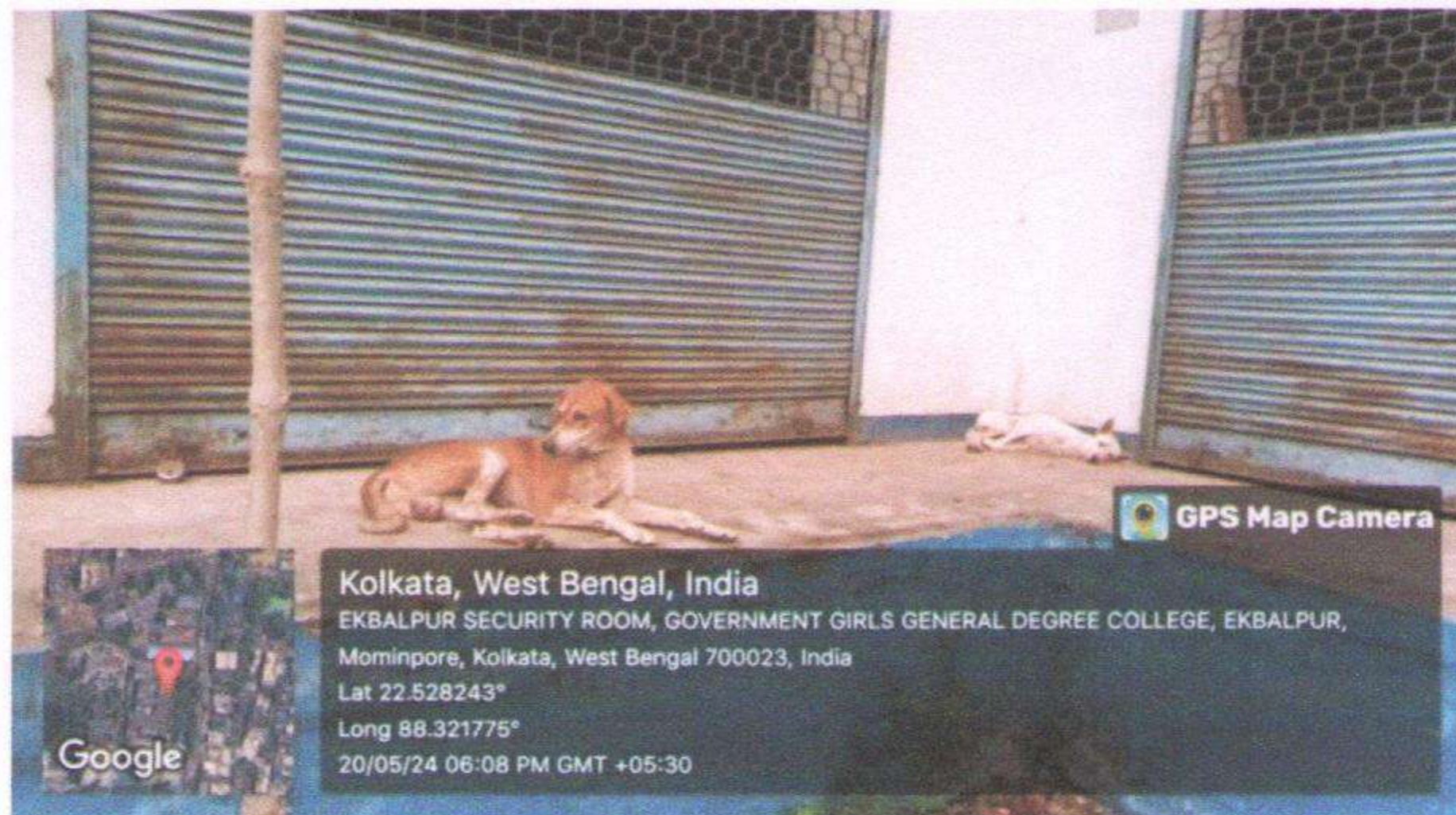


Figure 11: Photograph of a free-ranging dog the Campus

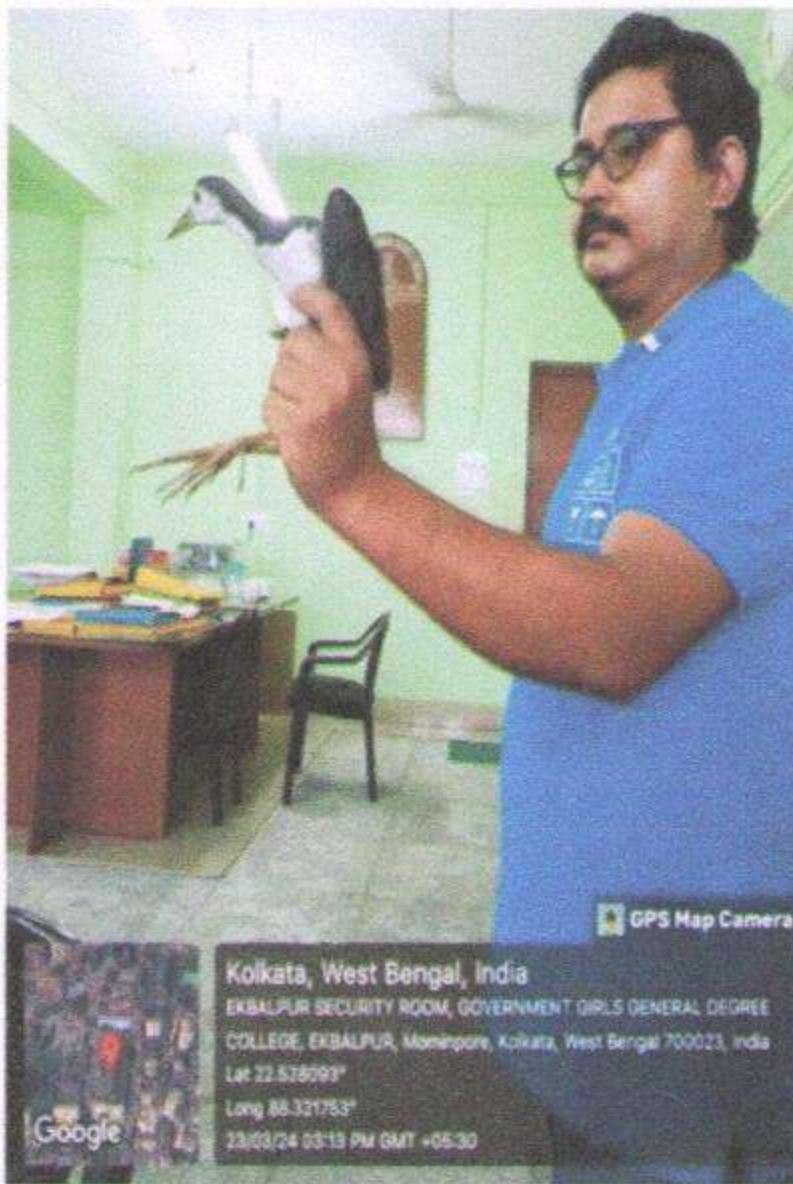

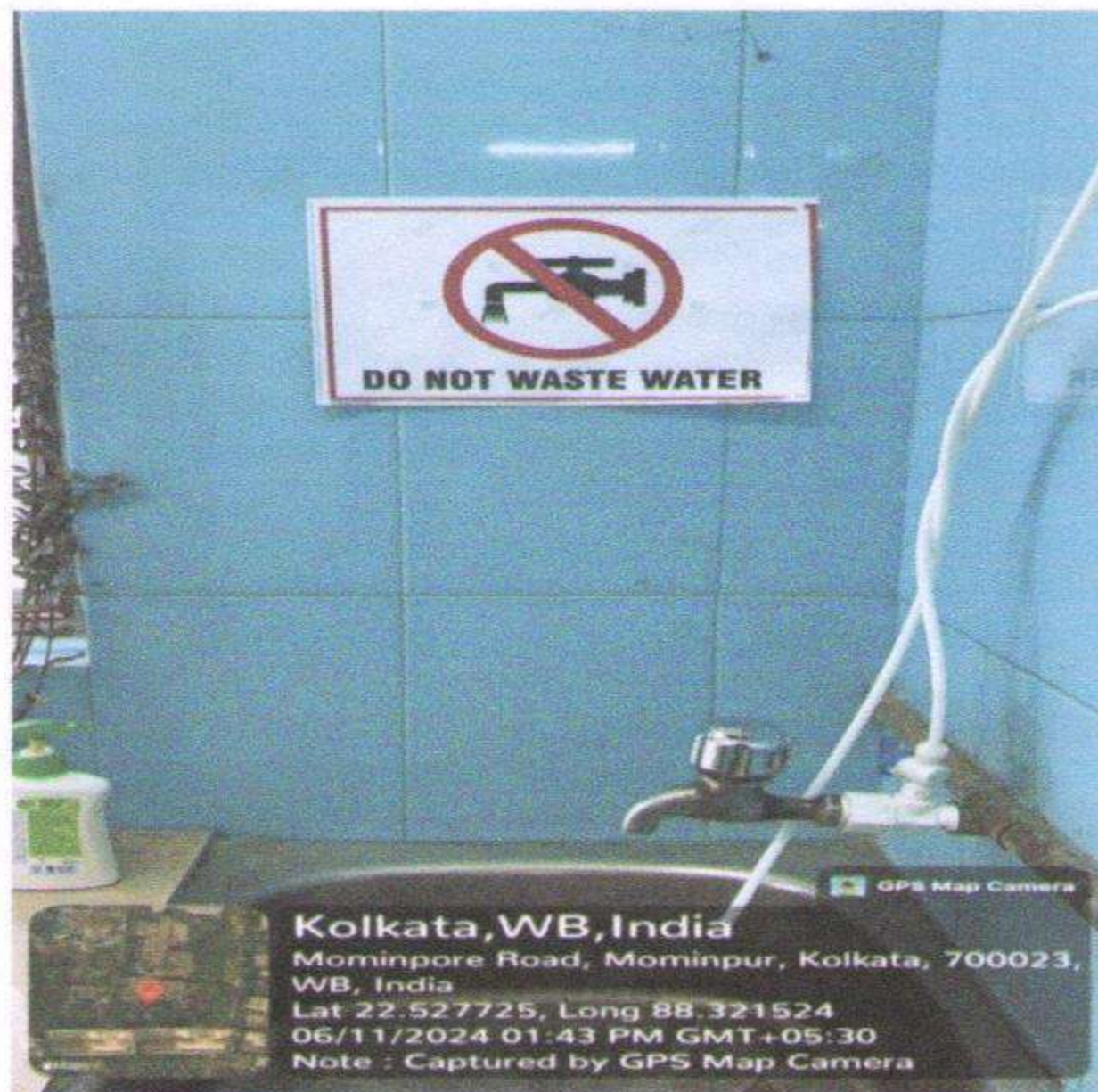


Figure 16. Slogan for water conservation

CARBON FOOT PRINT ASSESSMENT

19. ABOUT:

Carbon Footprint is a measure of total quantity of green house gases being emitted by an individual or an Institution as a result of its daily activities. Carbon Footprint tells the impact on the environment due to various activities inside the campus and quantifies the same in the form of total greenhouse gases being emitted. The most common greenhouse gases are carbon dioxide, water vapor, methane, nitrous oxide and ozone. Of all the greenhouse gases, carbon dioxide is the most prominent greenhouse gas, comprising 402 ppm of the Earth's atmosphere. There lease of carbon dioxide gas into the Earth's atmosphere through human activities is commonly known as carbon emissions. The question is what should be done to reduce carbon emissions. Many colleges want to reduce their carbon dioxide (CO₂) emissions but it is a difficult task, given a range of factors determine carbon emissions, including mobility, waste, and energy consumption. So, gaining insight into CO₂ emissions is extremely important. An important aspect of doing a carbon foot print audit is to account the carbon foot print of the campus by determining the net amount of greenhouse gas emitted from various activities in the campus so that they can adopt better ways to reduce its carbon foot print. One aspect is to consider the numbe of stakeholders travelled and mode of travel used to commute between home for students and staffs. So the carbon foot print auditing determine the total carbon foot print of the campus and analyzes whether the campus is eco- friendly and follows environmentally sustainable practices. It is therefore essential that any environmentally responsive Institution shall examine its carbon footprint.

19.1. Key Methodologies adopted for Carbon Footprint Audit

1. A walk through survey was conducted in the entire campus to observe various greenhouse gas emission points.
2. Walk through survey and base line data collection was done between 2022-23 seccion.
3. Based on the data collected, the Green House Gas Emission as CO₂ from the various sources was calculated.
4. Observation was done to see whether if the authorities have implementedany Carbon Footprint Reduction Strategy.

19.2. Carbon Footprint Auditing-Key Findings

Feasible emission inventories were selected to analyze the carbon footprint of the campus. The inventory survey was done for one academic year. The selected inventories are Human Factor, Transportation, Electricity, Solid Waste, Production and Consumption of Food, LPG & Natural Gas.

Data keepers are identified and the primary details were collected. Parameter wise and zone wisedetails were also collected. The received data were assembled and the missing gaps were recognized.

19.3. Human factor

Carbon dioxide emitted by a person per day is not negligible. It is equivalent to the mission of a car in a 5 km stretch. Humans emit 26 giga tons of carbon dioxide per year while CO₂ in the atmosphere is rising by only 15 gigatonnes per year. Just for breathing, humans emit per person each day 1140 grams of CO₂, assuming that they eat normally and follow a mean diet of 2800 kcal. The population details of each zone include the total number of teaching faculty; non-teaching staff and students were collected. The carbon dioxide emissions will be larger in the Zone having highest population. As the College Campus is concerned its limit is upto mark.

19.3. Transportation

Fossil fuels are used for transportation. The carbon dioxide emitted by different fuels is in different amounts. The engine of the vehicle burns fuel and creates a certain amount of CO₂, depending upon its fuel type, fuel consumption and the driving distances. One liter of petrol and diesel emits 2.3 kg and 2.7 kg of carbon dioxide, respectively. Travelling by car for 1000 km can produce about 200-230 kg of carbon dioxide in to the atmosphere. If a person travels by a bus for 1000 km, it can add 1075 kg of CO₂ to his/her Carbon foot print. Worldwide, the fossil fuels used for transportation contribute over 13% of GHG emissions.

The approximate transportation details for the Institution campus like the type of vehicle, No. of vehicles and the fuel used were collected. The carbon dioxide emitted from petrol is less compared to that of diesel. The Carbon footprint by the emission inventory transportation will be quite high.


It was noted that the there was no direct transportation under the control of institution but institution encourage Staffs and others to use Electronic Vehicle.

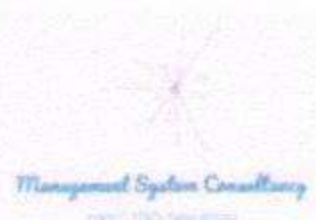
19.4. Electricity

Electricity is one emission inventory which contributes much to the Carbon footprint of the Institution. On an average, electricity sources emit 1.297 lbs CO₂ per kwh i.e. 0.0005883 metric tons of CO₂ perk Wh. The emission factor given by GRID 2010 version 1.1 for hydro electricity is 6.8956x 10⁻⁴ metrictons CO₂/k Wh. 50 grams of CO₂ is emitted from 1unit of solar power.

The details of the consumption of electricity were surveyed. If the number of classrooms and labs are more in a zone, consumption of electricity in that zone is more.

It was noted that the Institution uses a lot of Renewable power especially Solar Panel and LED lights as a supplement to conventional power there by reducing emission of GHG to the atmosphere also contributing to the INDC `commitment pledged by Government of India.

19.5. Solid waste

Generally, 1kg of solid waste is generated per capita per day. For high income countries, the solid waste generation is 1.1 – 5 kg per capita per day. For middle income countries, it is 0.52-1 kg and for low income countries the value is 0.45-0.89 kg/ capita/ day. One kilogram of solid waste can emit about 0.125 kg of carbon. The details regarding the solid waste generated in each zone is collected including the waste produced in canteen and hostels.

The solid waste generated in the canteen and hostel which is taken out of the campus comes under other indirect emissions. Solid Waste emits less amount of carbon dioxide compared to other emission inventories considered. Their Solid waste disposal process found ok, so exposure is less.

19.6. LPG And Natural Gas

The consumption of 1L of LPG can release 1.5kg of CO₂ to the atmosphere. Also, burning of wood (250kg) can add 33 kg of CO₂ to the Carbon footprint. The consumption details of LPG and Natural Gas in canteen and hostels were surveyed. It was noted that the Institution uses normal limit of LPG as required.

19.7. Carbon Footprint Analysis


Carbon footprint analysis can be done by suitably combining data collected with respective emission factor of the selected emission inventories. Table represents emission factors of the selected inventories.

- Vermicompost facility may be practiced, the product of which can be used as manure or fertilizer for plantation purpose.
- Sustainable use of resources and ecological balance of the College campuses must be maintained throughout the year.
- Increase the use of Electrical vehicle to reduce the pollution.
- Encourage to reduce dairy and meat in take - No Meat Mondays! Animal products makeup 18% of greenhouse gas emissions. By replacing one or two of weekly meat and dairy meals to a vegetarian option, can help reduce emissions
- Encourage use of Bicycles.
- Improve garden: To grow healthy plants, you also need healthy soil. Improving soil quality is an ongoing process for a gardener. Good, rich in nutrients, and friable soil will offer the plants everything all on its own. Thus, you would need lesser fertilizers and pesticides.
- Improve Water Harvesting:Various passive strategies have been accordingly developed in attempt to improve the water harvesting capability, which can be roughly categorized into three types: (i) engineering new surfaces or materials for condensers to benefit dew generation and removal; (ii) cooling the condensing substrates to facilitate the dewing occurrence; and (iii) concentrating the moisture from air by sorbent-assisted systems to inhibit the environmental influences and raise the water yield.
- Promote awarness build up programme on Environmental Issues time to time.

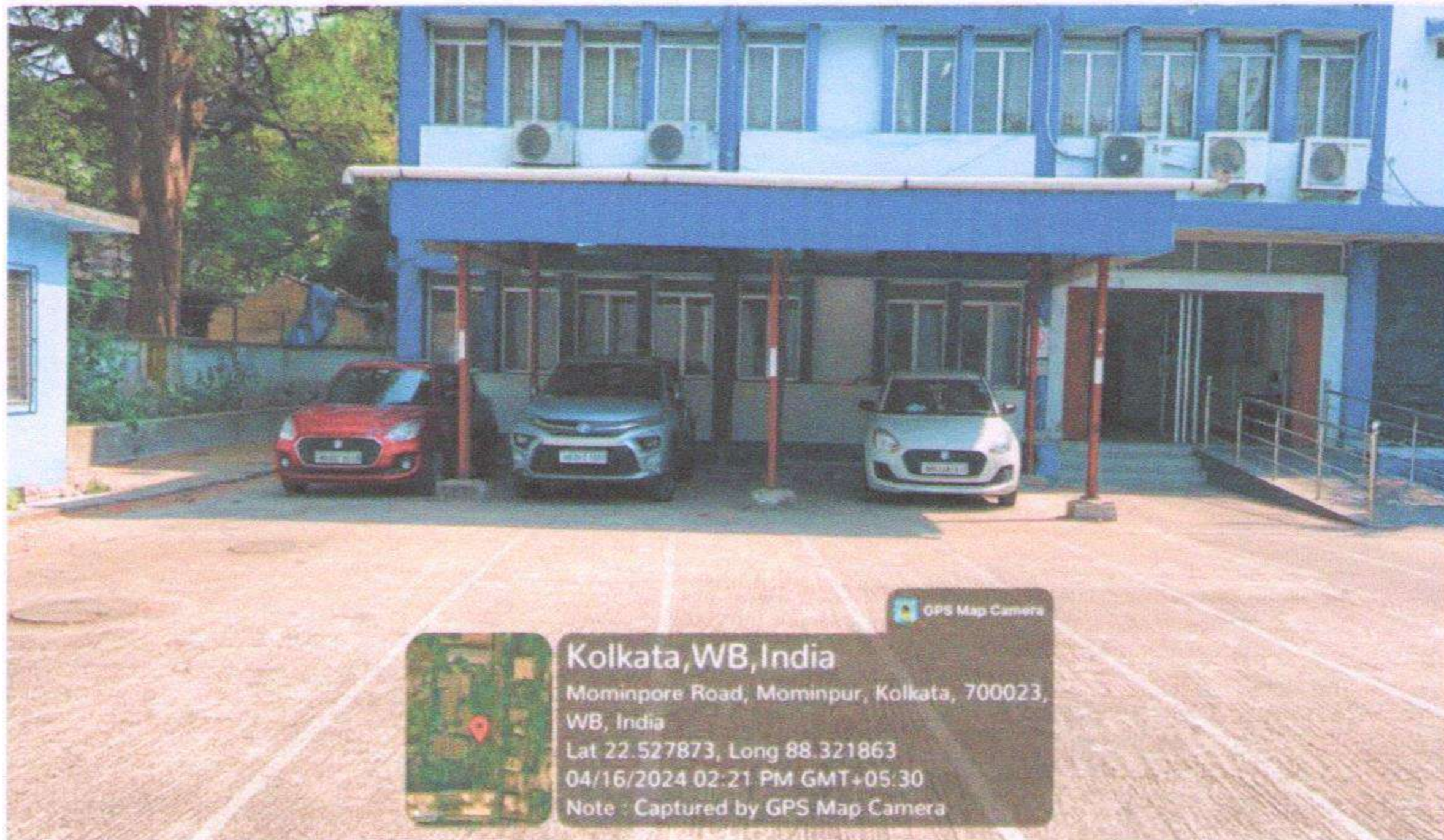

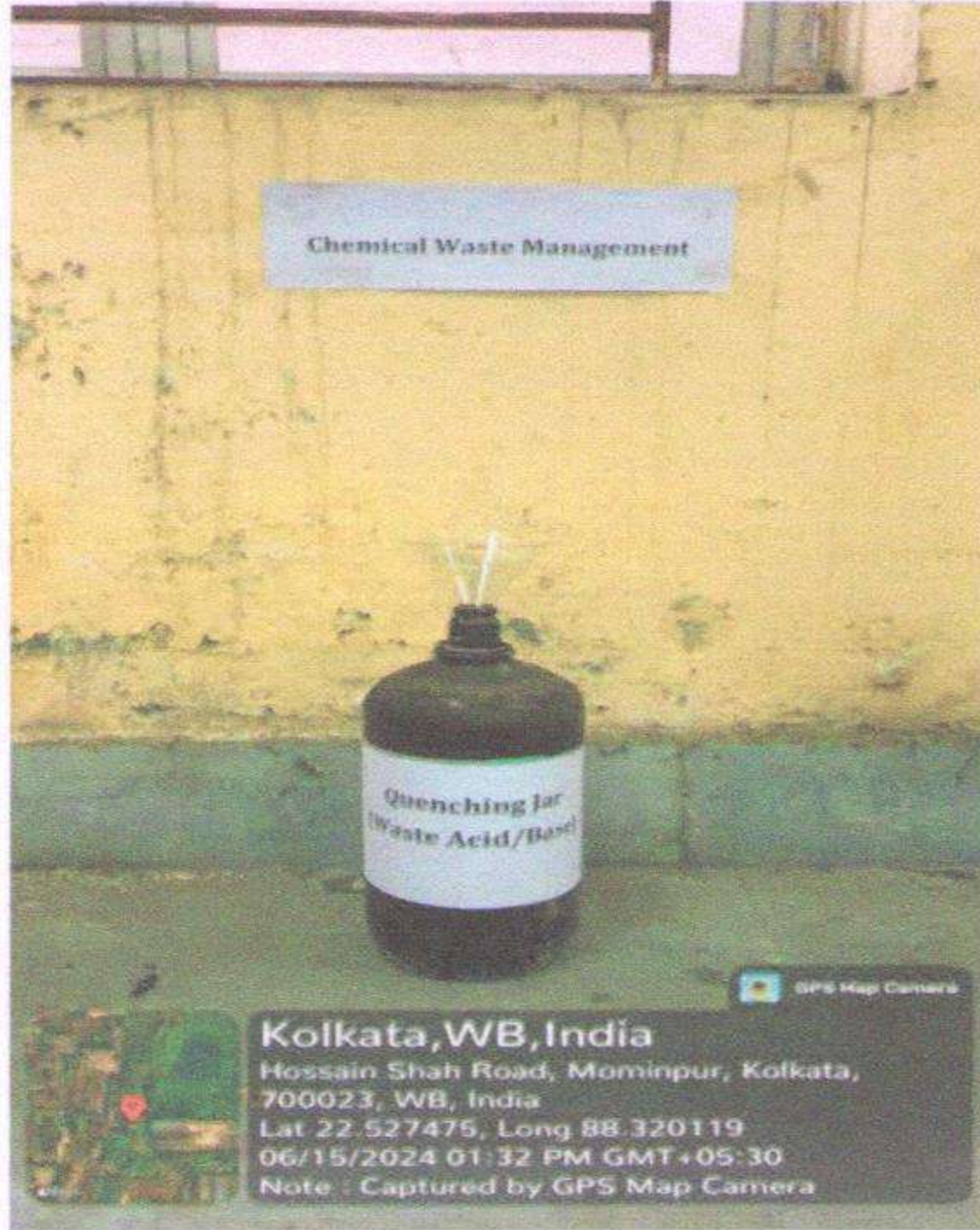


Figure 18. Sample Photograph of Management of the Chemical Waste

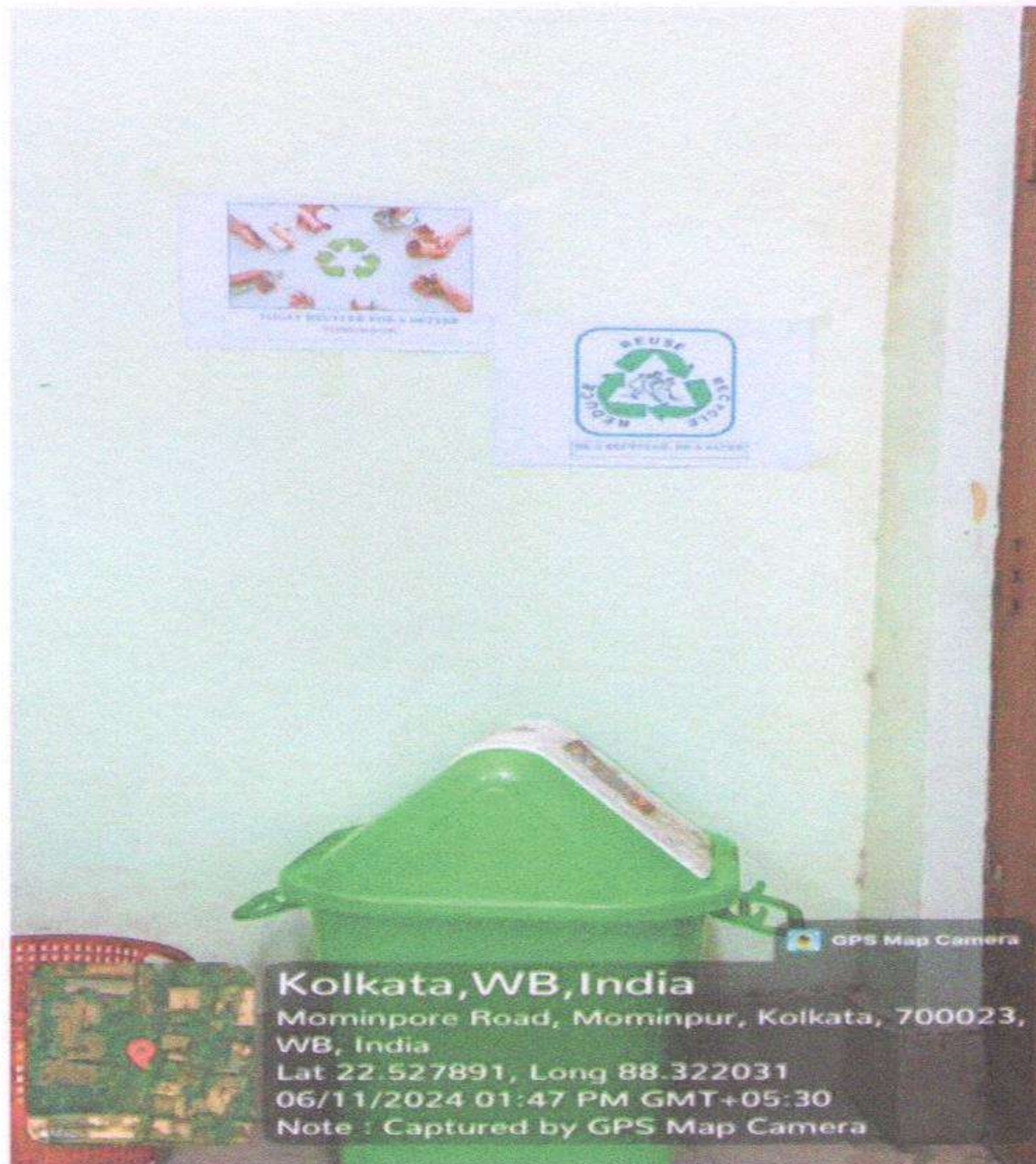


Figure 20. Slogan for reuse and recycle of waste materials
