10. **Objectives:** The objective of the seminar is to highlight the role of IPR in encouraging research, creativity, and knowledge creation within academic institutions. It also seeks to familiarize participants with different forms of intellectual property such as patents, copyrights, trademarks, and designs, and their relevance in transforming academic research into valuable intellectual assets. Furthermore, the seminar intends to motivate young scholars and innovators to safeguard their inventions, promote ethical research practices, and strengthen the culture of innovation in higher education institutions for sustainable academic and economic growth.

11. **Brief Report:** The seminar commenced at 12-30p.m. Dr. Joyjit Dhar, Convener, Institutions Innovation Council (IIC) welcomed the august gathering and also the distinguished speaker of the day. Revered Principal of the College, Dr. Syeda Shariqatul Moula Alquadri, felicitated the resource person and spoke about basic issues of IPR. Dr. Bhaswati Bhattacharya, NAAC Coordinator of the college was instrumental in delineating the nuances of the IPR in the context of artificial intelligence. At the beginning of the technical session, Dr. Joyjit Dhar introduced the erudite speaker of the day, Dr. Susil

Kumar Mitra, Professor of Practice, Xavier Law School, St. Xavier's University. The technical session started with an excellent and interactive presentation on the "Intellectual Property Rights" by Dr. Mitra, His presentation began with explaining the importance of IPR in the present scenario. Moreover, what is patent, the different tools available for patenting were also delineated in this session. The importance to file patents and how patent can be filed were discussed in detail. In this context, the patents classified into IPC (International patent classification), USPC (United States patent classification) and CPC (Cooperative patent classification) by World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO) were mentioned. His illustrious lecture described how a 12-year-old boy filed a patent on biopesticide (Laxman Rekha), what are the implications of the ideal blend of ingredients in making Sunrise Mustard paste, how Herbal Gulal can be prepared from "Polash" flower. He concluded the session by discussing the importance of copyright. Dr. Rajashree Dasgupta, HOD, Department of Geography and Joint NAAC Coordinator delivered a heartfelt vote of thanks, expressing gratitude to the Principal, Resource Person, IQAC Coordinator, Teachers Council Secretary, faculty and students for their valuable contributions to the seminar's success.

12. Outcome of the Seminar: This seminar provided a platform for all the participants to gain an understanding about IPR and the present scenario in our country. They were also learnt how small innovations can influence societies at large and how they should indulge in innovating and be careful in patenting ideas that will be useful for development of the common people of an emerging economy like ours.
