Purpose of this Activity:

- To create awareness among students and the community about Thalassemia, its causes, symptoms, prevention, and treatment.
- To educate volunteers, students, community people about the importance of premarital blood testing in preventing the transmission of thalassemia to future generations.
- To encourage early detection and preventive screening for thalassemia through free health check-up and blood screening test.
- To provide an opportunity for NSS volunteers to participate in social service and community welfare activities.

- To strengthen the spirit of humanitarian service, public health awareness, and social responsibility among students.
- To support the broader objective of building a healthier and more informed society through education and medical awareness initiatives.

Details: Thalassaemia Awareness Programme and Free Screening Test Camp was organized by NSS Unit-1 of Government Girls' General Degree College in association with Dr. B.C Roy Post Graduate Institute of Paediatrics Science, Kolkata on 6th May, 2026 with the aim of educating students about genetic disorders and promoting early screening for better health management. The programme commenced with a welcome address by Sutapa Bose, NSS Programme Officer and event coordinator, who emphasized the importance of this test for society. This programme was chaired by Dr. Syeda Shariqatul Moula Alquadri, Principal, Government Girls' General Degree College who gave her remarkable speech on importance of Thalassaemia. During the event, Medical Professional Mrs. Madhumita Samanta briefed students about the importance of Thalassaemia testing, explaining that Thalassaemia is a hereditary blood disorder that can be prevented through timely screening, especially before marriage and during pregnancy. She highlighted that carriers of Thalassaemia may not show symptoms but can pass the disorder to the next generation, making awareness and testing crucial. Total 53 students participated in the free testing camp and voluntarily underwent Thalassaemia Screening Tests. The event was concluded with a vote of thanks to the medical team and organizing committee.



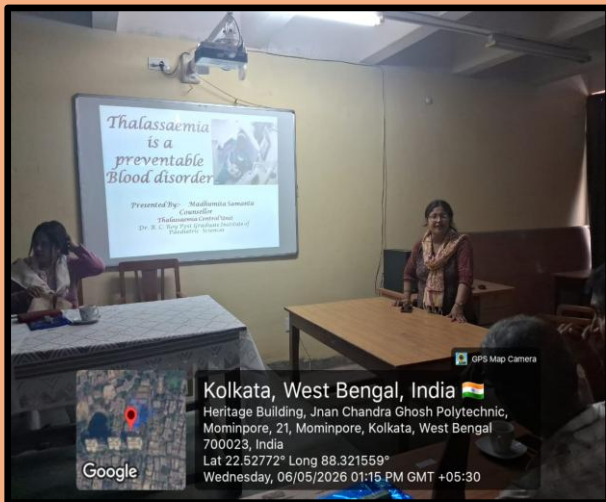
